Item 1

The sale of lollies at break time on a Friday and the second-hand uniform shop has generated £530 in the School Council funds plus we have repaid our initial loan from the School to buy the picnic benches.

On average we raise £40 plus each week from the sale of lollies.

Now we need to decide how these funds are going to be spent for the pupils in our school.

We discussed to possible options:

- To keep saving, in order to buy much larger equipment;
- To spend on a number of smaller projects.

Each class will discuss how they would like the council to spend these funds.

Playground markings e.g. large chess board/pieces

Year 5

Scooter/cycle racks

Chalk

Quiet area

Climbing frame, board games for wet playtimes, football goals

Trim trail/ Big Playground equipment

Year 4

Umbrellas

Year 4 also suggested a rota of playground games as currently it is dominated by football. Could the staff on duty referee the games? How about 2 days of football – 1 day for years 3&4 and 1 day for years 5&6? Then 2 days for Basketball on the same basis as the football. Then a day of other ball games.

Years 2&3 have yet to feedback from their classes.

Item 2

At next week's meeting we will short list the application forms and draw up a list of pupils to be interviewed.

Item 3

Each class have been asked to come up with a set of playground rules based on the school values. The School Council will then use these to suggest a set of playground rules to be printed on boards in the playtime areas.
