Star Readers!

Don't forget to read with your child at home to help them achieve their 'star reader' awards!

Just a recap of how this works:

Every five times a child has read at home (once per day) they receive a sticker or star on their reading record. After they have ten stickers or stars they receive a star reader certificate and a book in assembly. This is equivalent to receiving a book for every fifty reads. We will no longer be giving out the smaller prizes but this will mean the children will receive books more frequently. Once each child receives a book, they start again, working towards their next book.

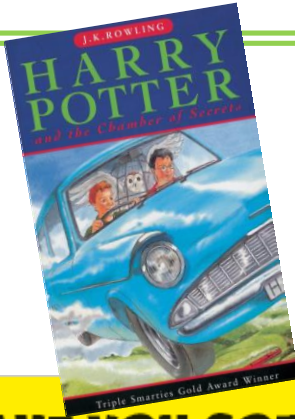

Admission Policy Consultations

Carisbrooke College and Medina College

In accordance to 15(b) of the Schools Admissions Code the Governing Body of the Island Innovation Federation are consulting on the Admissions Arrangements for September 2019. As the admissions authority the governing body has amended the policy to include an additional admissions criterion to be used if there are more applications than there are available places. The additional criterion gives priority to children of staff who have (1) been employed at the school for two or more years at the time at which the application for admission to the school is made, or (2) have been recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
