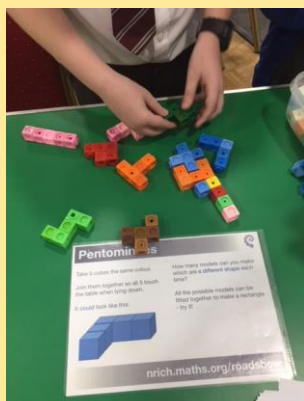
Isle Dance
