Healthy Lunches

Children in Years R - 2 are entitled to universal free school lunches or you can provide your child with a packed lunch. Years 3 – 6 can pay for a school lunch or bring their own packed lunch.

We are an allergy aware school, so children should not bring in any item of food that contains nuts (including Nutella!)

Please also do not include chocolate bars, sweets or fizzy drinks in packed lunches.

If you believe that you are entitled to free school meals, please complete an application form on the IW Council website or collect a form from the school office.

Reception – Year 6 – 3pm

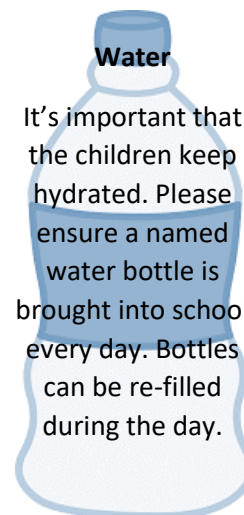
Nursery

Afternoon session – Starts at 12.15pm and ends at 2.45pm

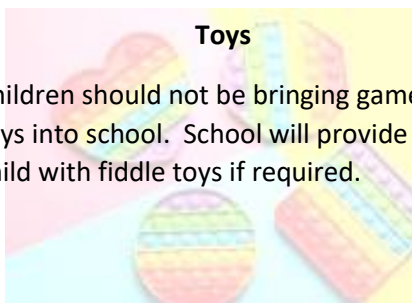
Water

It's important that the children keep hydrated. Please ensure a named water bottle is brought into school every day. Bottles can be re-filled during the day.



Toys

Children should not be bringing games or toys into school. School will provide your child with fiddle toys if required.



Tuck at break time

There will be tuck available to buy at break time. Details of this will be given in September 2022.



Attendance

It is a requirement that parents/carers let us know, on the first day of any absence, why their child is not at school by 9am. On the first day of your child's return, the reason for absence must be given to the office in writing.

School Uniform

School uniform can be purchased from The Big White T-Shirt Company.

Nursery & Reception can wear a burgundy T-shirt as they are encouraged to join in with messy and outside play.

Years 1 & 2 are required to wear white polo shirts and grey skirts/trousers/shorts.

From Year 3 (KS2) children are required to wear a white shirt and school tie.

All children should wear black shoes or black trainers.

PE kit – All children are required to wear the full PE kit from Reception – Year 6.

Mobile phones

If your child needs to bring a mobile phone to school, it must be handed in to the school office or class teacher on arrival and collected at the end of the day.

Suitable Outerwear

Children in Nursery and Reception can leave a pair of wellies at school as they will be playing outside in all weathers.

Children will need to bring a coat to school that is suitable for the weather for that day (raincoat for wet weather, light jacket in the summer). A sun hat will be needed for all children during the summer term.

Break time snacks

Children in Reception, Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 need to bring in their own healthy snack for break time. Children in Years 1 & 2 are provided with fruit by the fruit scheme. As we are part of the healthy school's network, please do not provide chocolate bars, sweets or crisps for break times. Please see below images of suitable break time snacks.

Curriculum

All the children have access to wide curriculum. If you would like to know more, please see our Curriculum Maps (under Parents) on the school website.

- Use precision apparatuses accurately
- Use direct speech and inverted commas to punctuate this accuracy

- Describe positions on a grid using coordinates
- Describe the relationships between problems on the same theme
