Attendance

It is a requirement that parents/carers let us know, on the first day of any absence, why their child is not at school by 9am. The school register will be taken at 8.30am, the school gate will remain open until 8.40am. All pupils arriving after this time are required to report to the main office with their parents, who will be expected to sign the late book and provide a reason for their absence.

If their arrival is after 8.30am it will be recorded as late - L code (Late before the close of register).

All pupils arriving after 8.45am will be marked as having a U code (Late after the close of register). Parents will be contacted to discuss any patterns of late arrival.

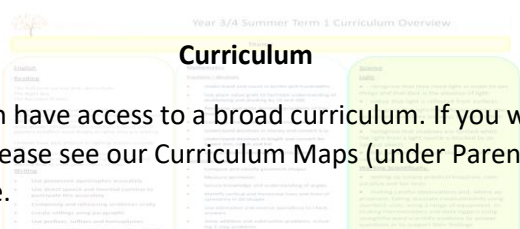
Holidays

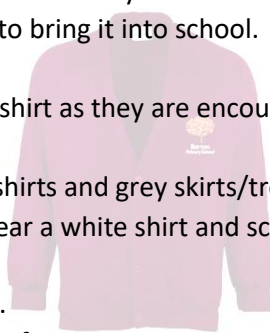
School Uniform

All children are expected to wear the correct school uniform. If your child arrives at school without the correct uniform, parents/carers will be contacted and asked to bring it into school.

- Nursery & Reception can wear a burgundy T-shirt as they are encouraged to join in with messy and outside play.
- Years 1 & 2 are required to wear white polo shirts and grey skirts/trousers/shorts.
- From Year 3 (KS2) children are required to wear a white shirt and school tie.

All children should wear black shoes or black trainers.

PE kit – All children are required to wear the full PE kit from Reception – Year 6.



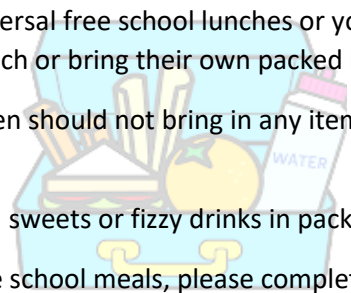
Healthy Lunches

Children in Years R - 2 are entitled to universal free school lunches or you can provide your child with a packed lunch. Years 3 – 6 can pay for a school lunch or bring their own packed lunch.

We are an allergy aware school, so children should not bring in any item of food that contains nuts (including Nutella!)

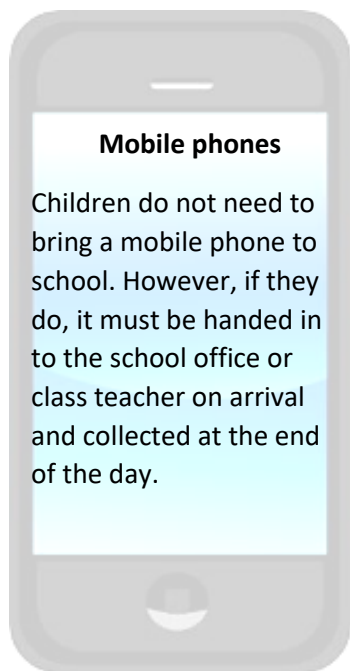
Please also do not include chocolate bars, sweets or fizzy drinks in packed lunches.

Mobile phones

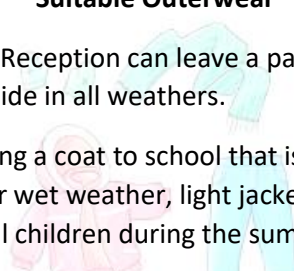
Children do not need to bring a mobile phone to school. However, if they do, it must be handed in to the school office or class teacher on arrival and collected at the end of the day.



Suitable Outerwear

Children in Nursery and Reception can leave a pair of wellies at school as they will be playing outside in all weathers.

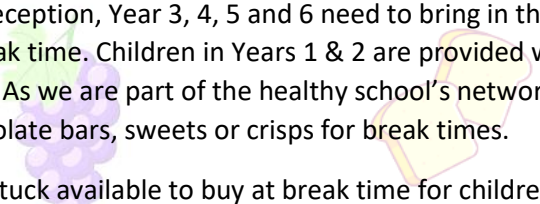
Children will need to bring a coat to school that is suitable for the weather for that day (raincoat for wet weather, light jacket in the summer). A sun hat will be needed for all children during the summer term.



Break time snacks and tuck

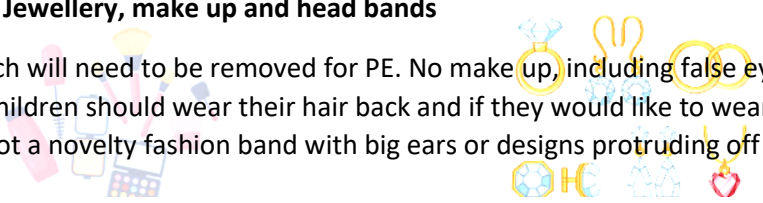
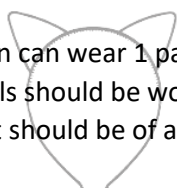
Children in Reception, Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 need to bring in their own healthy snack for break time. Children in Years 1 & 2 are provided with fruit by the fruit scheme. As we are part of the healthy school's network, please do not provide chocolate bars, sweets or crisps for break times.

There will be tuck available to buy at break time for children in KS2. Toast 10p and a fruit pot 10p.



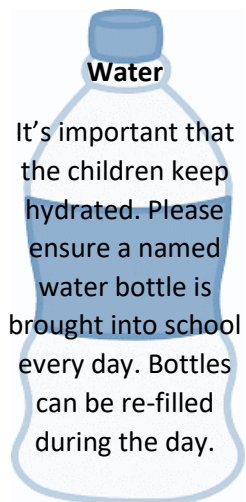
Jewellery, make up and head bands

Children can wear 1 pair of studs which will need to be removed for PE. No make up, including false eye lashes and nails should be worn to school. Children should wear their hair back and if they would like to wear a hair band, it should be of a plain design, not a novelty fashion band with big ears or designs protruding off it.



Water

It's important that the children keep hydrated. Please ensure a named water bottle is brought into school every day. Bottles can be re-filled during the day.



Walking home

We encourage independence for our Years 5 & 6 by walking home independently. Please inform the school in writing, if you would like your child to do so.



Toys and equipment, including pencil cases

School will provide your child with all the equipment they will need for the school day. Children should not bring in any toys, games or pencil cases. In consultation with the SENCo, a fiddle toy will also be provided, if necessary.
