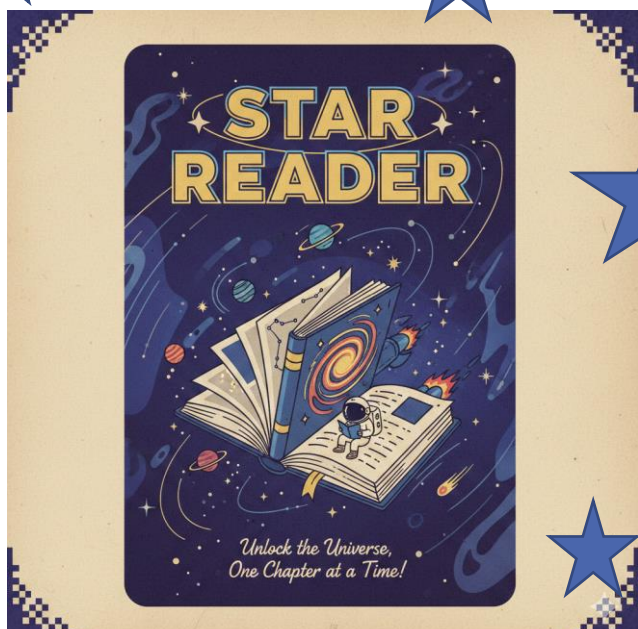

EARLY SIGNS



Hives, itching swelling (face, lips, tongue), skin redness.

Shortness of breath, wheezing.
Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.
Dizziness, lightheaded.

PROGRESSION



Severe difficulty breathing

Tightening of throat, throat, hoarseness
Weak, rapid pulse
Confusion, anxiety
Severe abdominal pain

EMERGENCY



IMMEDIATE ACTION:

1. ADMINISTER EPINEPHRINE (EPI-PEN).
2. CALL 911
3. LAY FLAT, RAISE LEGS.
4. LOOSEN CLOTHING

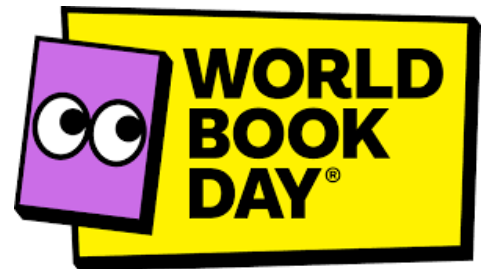
World Book Day
