Transferring to Secondary School (Current Year 6)

The deadline for transport applications to be submitted for students transferring to Secondary School is 1st May 2026. To make an application please visit our website <https://www.iow.gov.uk/article/2418/Apply-for-home-to-school-transport>.

Transport for eligible children, whose applications were received on time in line with the dates above, will be allocated to transport by the end of August, and Parents/Carers will be notified about those arrangements via email. For a small number of cases who may require complex transport arrangements, these may not be able to start in September and parents/carers will be notified if this is the case.

Applications received after the deadline will be treated as 'late applications' and can only be reviewed after all on-time applications have been processed. For the families of eligible children who apply late, this means that transport may not be in place for the start of the school term in September and may not be available for the first school term. During this time transport arrangements including costs will be parents' responsibility.

Safety Notice

I am writing to make you aware of a significant and immediate public safety concern relating to the former Cygnet Hotel in Sandown.

We have been alerted by partners, including Hampshire Police, that the building is now in an extremely dangerous condition. An independent structural engineer's report has confirmed that the site presents a **severe and unpredictable risk of structural collapse**. The building has been affected by fire damage, water ingress, and deterioration of key structural elements, meaning that parts of the structure could fail suddenly and without warning.

Of particular concern are recent reports that young people have been accessing the site. In addition to the risk of collapse, there are known hazards present including **drugs paraphernalia, sharps, and asbestos**. The situation is so serious that police officers have been advised **not to enter the building under any circumstances**.

We would ask that you:

- **Remind children** of the dangers associated with accessing derelict buildings
- Encourage clear messaging that this site must **not be entered under any circumstances**
